PROGRAM OVERVIEW

In the event of power loss, paper jams or other unforeseen difficulties, the Check Writing Restart program is provided. This program should not be performed until the DETAILED CHECK REGISTER is completed.

PROGRAM OPERATION

The Check Writing Restart program is similar to the Print Checks program. The difference between this routine and the Print Checks routine is that after test checks have been printed, you will be asked, "Restart check writing with what vendor?". Enter the VENDOR ID whose check was being printed at the time of the interruption. If an ID is entered for a vendor for whom there are no checks to be printed, it will be necessary to re-enter a valid vendor ID. The check writing will resume with the check whose ID has been entered. Once the correct vendor ID has been entered, enter the check date and number for the restart. When the last check has been printed, you will be asked, "Is everything O.K. (Y/N)?" Processing from this point is identical to the Print Checks routine. For more information, see {APCHKWRI}.
