PROGRAM OVERVIEW

This is a neat little program that can be placed anywhere in the menu system where printing functions exist, so that the users can have access to all the network printers. This provides simple print routing. Automatically programmed are the No Form Feed or <NFF> and the No Banner <NB> functions.

PROGRAM OPERATION

ENTER YOUR CHOICE ----->: You are first prompted to choose a printer. You can <PageUp> or <PageDown> to locate the printer of your choice. You can hit the <F7> key to switch to the setup screen to install a new printer.

RECORD#: You do not have access to this field. An entry is automatically created for you that is actually the printer code. You will see this code after you save a new printer and switch back to the first screen.

DESCRIPTION: After you hit the <F7> key, the cursor will move to this field. Type in a logical name of the printer and something else to identify the printer further. We suggest that along with the actual name of the printer, you abbreviate the printer function.

QUEUE NAME: This is the actual Novell print queue name as you set up in the Novell print functions.

SERVER NAME: This is the name of the server that the print queue discussed above resides on. You may need to consult with you network manager or support personnel to obtain this information. You may also contact IBS support to help you obtain this information also.
